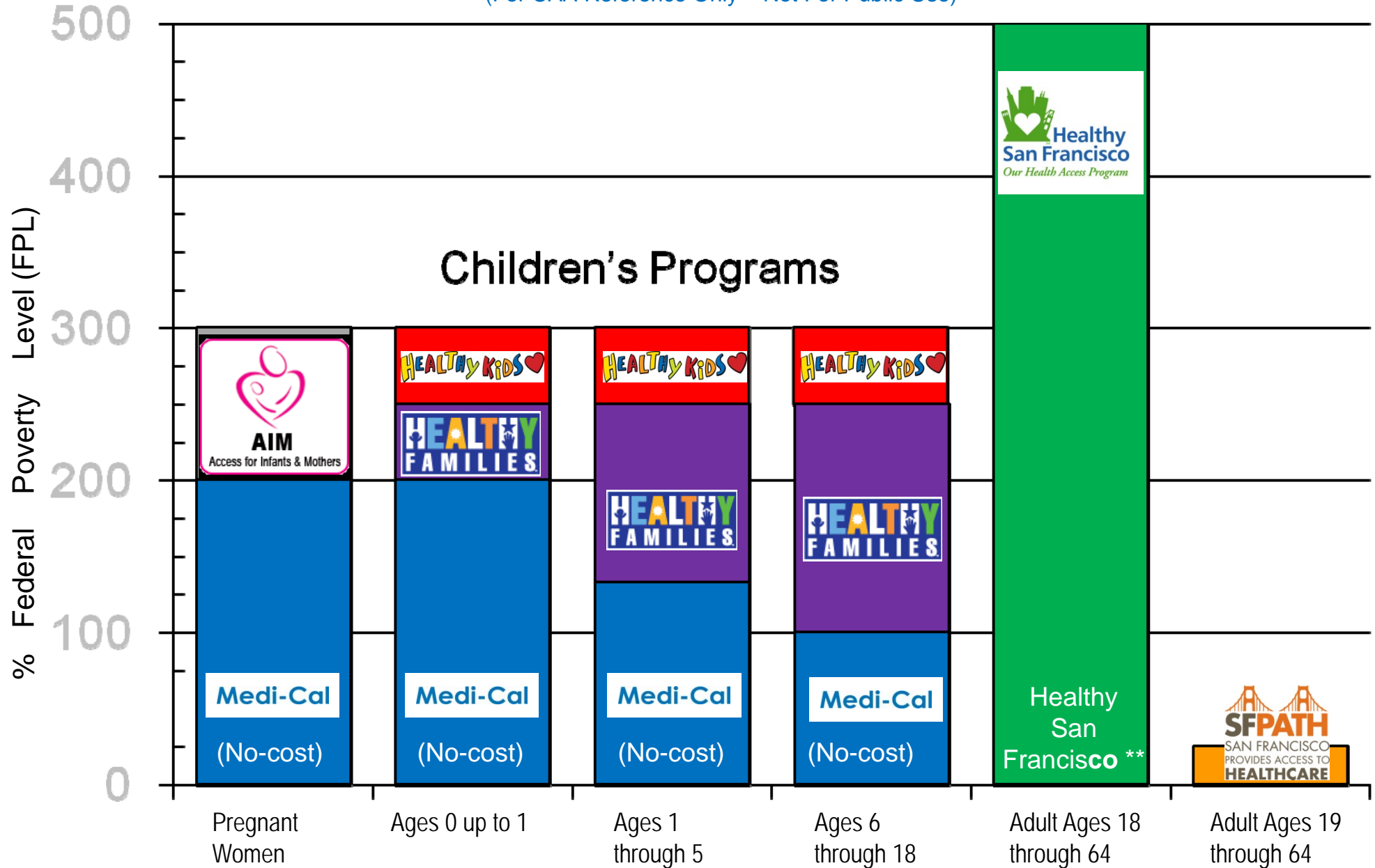


# Federal Poverty Level(FPL) Guidelines for Health Programs\*

Effective April 1, 2012 through March 31, 2013

(For CAA Reference Only – Not For Public Use)



\*For children over 300% FPL, refer to your local community clinic with a sliding scale program or Medi-Cal Share of Cost Program

\*\*For Healthy San Francisco, certain assets are counted in total income and are screened for Medi-Cal first

Adults with children, who are aged, blind, or disabled may be eligible for Medi-Cal

## Determining Family Size

### Family Size: Who Counts

- Parents
  - Married
  - unmarried
- Spouses
- Stepparents
- Children under age 21 (full, half, step)
- Children under age 21 (full, half, step) away at school AND claimed as a tax dependant
- Unborn children of any family member

### Family Size: Who Doesn't Count

- Caretaker relatives
  - Grandparents
  - Uncles
- Legal guardians
- Foster parents
- Recipients of most forms of public assistance
  - SSI/SSP
  - CalWORKS
  - TANF
  - General Relief
- Unmarried father of an unborn child, if he has no other children with the pregnant woman
- Roommates, friends, and others

"Determining Family Size" applies to children's programs only

A pregnant woman is counted as two family members
